- 5. Pack light, carry on only, you would pay \$60 each way to check a bag and you would slow the group down
- 6. All students will need to comply with all HFCHS behavioral expectations as noted in the student handbook. Of particular note, the following behaviors will result in students being sent home at their parents cost:
 - a. drinking;
 - b. any use of substances not allowed for minors in the US;
 - c. violation of any safety rules we establish before or during the trip;

- 8. Trip cost includes hotel, breakfast, transportation, individual supplementary travel insurance, museum entrances, and multiple dinners.
- 9. Students should have enough money for most lunches, incidental costs and spending money. Let's say around \$300 minimum.
- 10. Fundraisers are fun although generally not very lucrative. If you want to do one, please volunteer to coordinate your idea.
- 11. Room assignments. Special requests may cost more.
- 12. Curfew every night
- 13. Arrive at MSP airport by 1:00pm June 12
- 14. Pick up at MSP airport at 5:30pm on July 22

Packing Checklist

- 5 shirts/blouses: long- and short-sleeve
- 1 sweater or lightweight fleece
- 2 pairs pants/ skirts
- 1 pair shorts
- 1 swimsuit
- 5 pairs underwear and socks
- 1 pajamas/nightgown
- 1 pair of walking shoes (we will walk a lot)
- Slippers/flipflops for in the hotel
- 1 rainproof jacket with hood
- Money belt
- Money—your preferred mix of:
 - Credit card (call company to make sure it will work in Italy)
 - Dollars to be exchanged or Euros from the bank before you go or a CC that can be used at an ATM
- Passport and any supporting docs (needed only for things like: non-American citizens or people who can't go through airport scanners...)
- Essential electronics
- Appropriate chargers
- Electronic converter
- Daypack
- Empty water bottle
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, floss, deodorant, sunscreen)
- Medicines (Mr. Dueck can carry EpiPens etc. if need be)
- Glasses/contacts/sunglasses (with prescriptions)
